## **Review of Previous Meeting's Minutes:**

#### **CSIP**

- Focus on reading and math-using DIBELS testing for this for K-3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> will use the SRI
- Our goal on the CSIP has been set for 86% for K-3<sup>rd</sup>. For 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade it has been set for 64%
- · Teachers are pushing all the students to make growth
- 4 reading aides, 2 math aides, and one enrichment aide
- Drama or music grant for brain boosters
- Reviewed the CSIP as a SCC team and signed off on the form

#### **Cell Tower Budget**
