If you would like to go with your child's class on a field trip or volunteer in their classroom you will need to go through the **CSD volunteer application process**. This process is required every school year, and needs to be completed for the current school year if you haven't done this already. It will save time if you sign up before arriving at school to volunteer. The process can take 48 to 72 hours to complete after you have entered in your personal information. Policy mandates that all volunteers working directly with students need to complete the volunteer application.
