School Attendance Policy:

- Reviewed where we are standing with attendance regarding students
- Why are we having these absences
- Parents need information to understand the correlation between the students, their grades, the teacher's "report card" and the principal's "report card."
- General letter with the concepts that are being covered each month sent home so that parents know-keep it specific enough
 - This can be discussed during BLT
 - This can be used as a strategy to help with attendance

CSIP/LAND Trust

- Overall our plan has stayed similar to the current year
- Determine student needs at the beginning of the year-instruction in the classroom as well as tier 2
- We want to make sure that we have high expectations for all students
- 4 interventionists currently at Willow Canyon. We are looking to hire a 5th interventionist for next year.
- If there is money left over for additional instruction it will be added to technology

- Resilience: training the teachers on ways to handle behaviors and help students to build resilience.
- TSSP: money will be coming soon. It will require a plan similar to the CSIP plan. This would be an ongoing budget.
- Reviewed Sage and Dibels scores: overall our data is looking really good. Teachers have implemented skill based instruction and the various professional development that they have received.
