#### **Policy Review:**

1. Annual nutrition and physical activity update district policy 300.3-3.

a. The **school breakfast and lunch programs** are based on having a healthy diet for children that promotes eating fruits and vegetables and other healthy foods.

B. We also focus on being healthy and getting enough exercise and activity through our **weekly physical education program** and during recess so students have daily rigorous physical activity.
