

## Willow Canyon Elementary End of Year LAND Trust Summary Report 2019-2020

Willow Canyon Elementary is grateful for the additional finding of \$48,491 for our improvement efforts during the 2019/20 school year. We followed our LAND Trust plan as it was written. Teachers met in weekly collaboration meetings to look at student benchmark and progress monitoring data. They met with all of the instructional aides once per month to discuss student progress. Three of the four reading aides focused on providing reading interventions for struggling students. One reading aide provided enrichment activities that were more complex reading and writing tasks. We also provided additional math instruction for students who were struggling and activities for students who were excelling. These programs are for all students as the need is determined to provide additional instruction and support. All of the instructional aides are trained and supported so the interventions they provide are targeted, accommodate student needs, and are additional instruction.

We were only able to complete the fall and winter benchmarking tests due to the school soft closure starting March 13, 2020 and extending through the end of the 2019/20 school year. Our scores indicate we met two of our goals and had work to do to achieve the other two goals as indicated by the scores below. After considering the Acadience Reading and the Reading Inventory scores we determined we needed to consider the support and instruction we were providing for struggling students. We completed an addendum to our plan to include funding for additional instructional aide time to work in classes that were too large in size and additional time for the behavior aide. We also purchased the 95% Group curriculum with school funds to use in our reading intervention program that LAND Trust funds to assist the reading aides with providing more focused reading instruction to target specific learning gaps.
