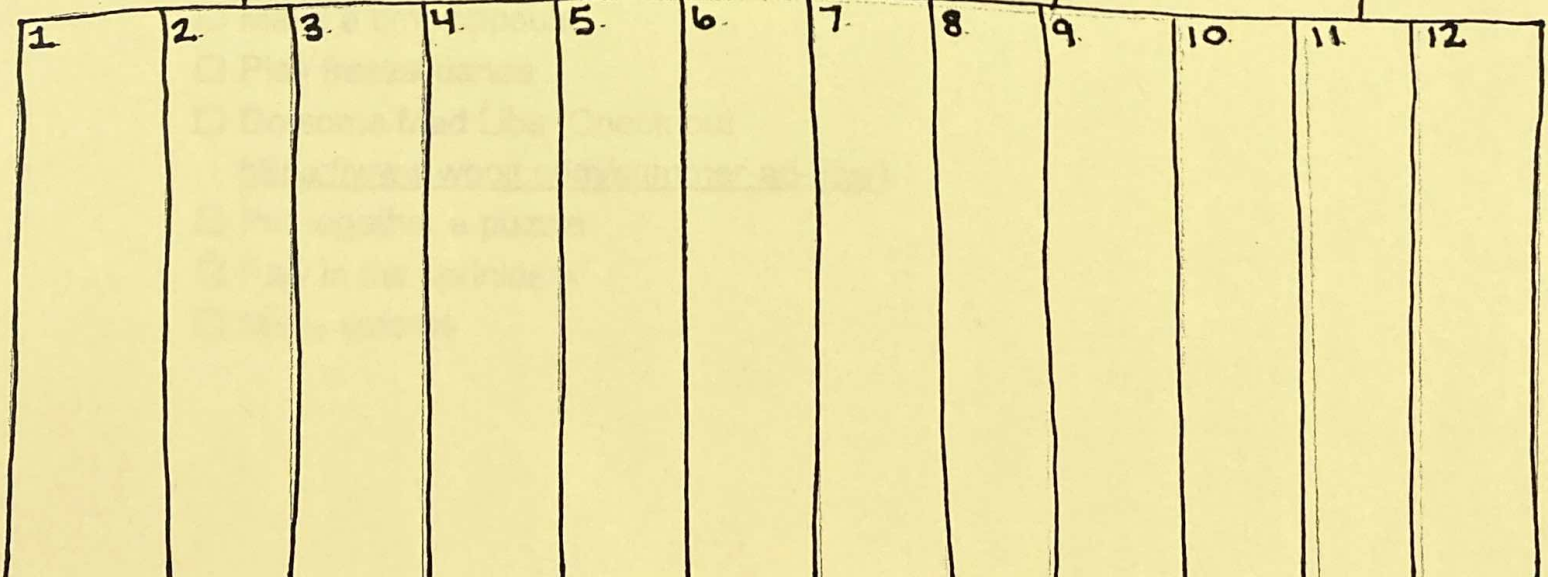
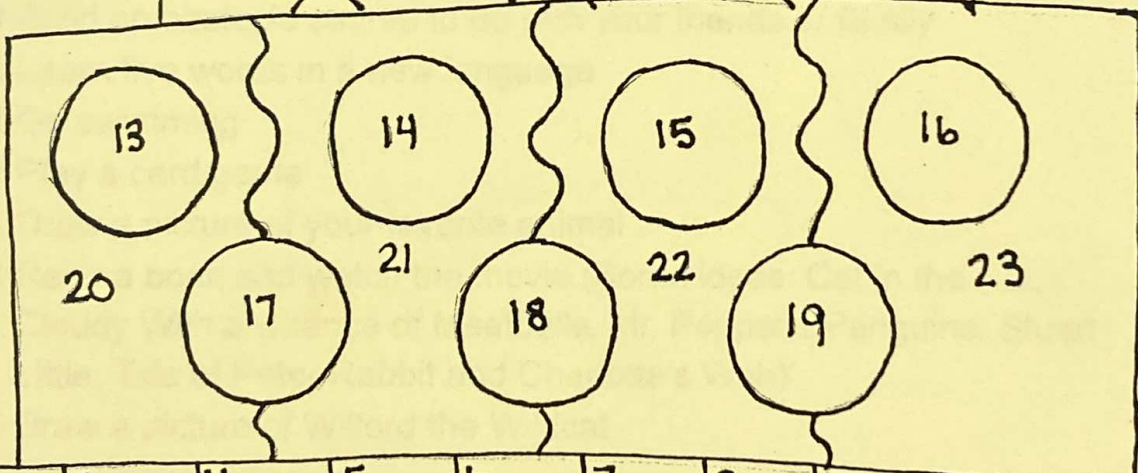
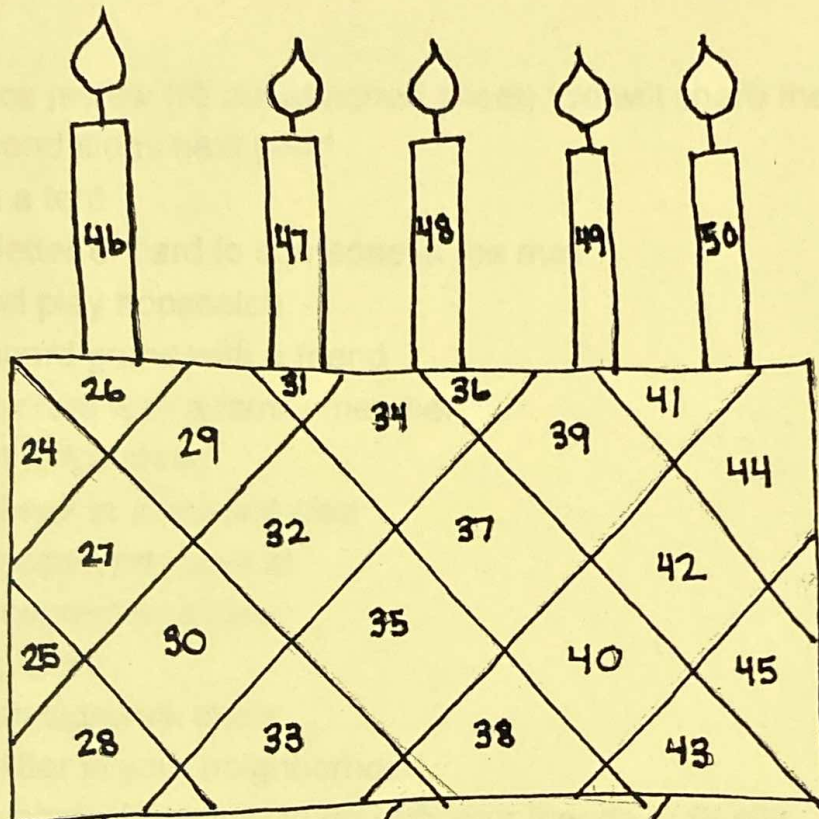

Wildcat Summer Activities:

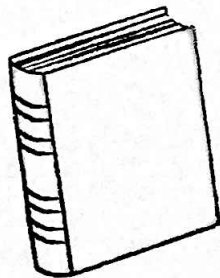
- Do a book review (fill out attached sheet) We will share the recommendations next year!
